Madam/Sir,

As you are aware, in the wake of COVID 19 pandemic almost all Kendriya Vidyalayas have functioned in virtual mode during the session 2021-2022. In view of the prevailing unprecedented situation CBSE has also changed the examination pattern and introduced Term wise Special Scheme of Assessment system for classes IX to XII for the session 2021-22. It was therefore felt that some relaxation and flexibility should be extended to the students of KVs in these extraordinary times. Accordingly, the Competent Authority of KVS has approved the following framework for conduct of Session Ending Examinations and promotion for the session 2021-22 -

- 1. A Virtual Meeting may be organized at School Level with parents to familiarize them with Examination Process, Assessment/Evaluation and Promotion rules for the Session Ending Examination 2022.
- 2. Parent's consent should invariably be taken for Offline Examination
- 3. The Internal Assignment/Project and Practical Examination should be completed in advance.
- 4. At least 4 sets of Question Papers to be prepared for each class.
- 5. Deputy Commissioners are requested to conduct VC with all Principals & Question paper Setters (expert teachers) of Class IX & XI about setting of Question Papers to avoid any issues.
- 6. During setting of questions paper teachers may be directed to ensure content coverage, accuracy, use of appropriate and correct language while framing the questions in order to avoid ambiguity. The moderations work may be taken up accordingly.
- 7. Blue Print for the Session Ending Examination, 2021-22 (Term-2) may be prepared at Regional level and circulated to all KVs in advance.

- 8. The platform for conducting examination should also be familiar/user friendly for students & teachers.
- 9. Staggered time slots are to be followed for the examinations of various classes.
- 10. For every class, 2 or 3 different time slots may be planned to address the problem of limited devices and connectivity.
- 11. Additional time should be given to the students for Uploading Answer Sheets for Online Examination.
- 12. The sanctity and confidentiality of Examination Process must be ensured.

PROMOTION and SUPPLEMENTARY EXAM-

- No Detention Policy will continue as per RTE Act in Classes I to VIII.
- Passing criteria for class IX and XI students will be same as previous year.
- All care should be taken to ensure accuracy in preparation of Results by carrying out rechecking / moderation before declaration of result also through Offline/Online Mode.
- KVS (HQ) Office Memorandum F. No. 110355/01/2019-20/KVS (HQ)/sports/ BOG/ 480, dated 21.05.2020 related to 'Additional Marks will be awarded to the students of class VI-IX & XI to promote in higher class in Session Ending Examination, 2021-2022 after calculation of main marks/aggregate' will be applicable for the session 2021-22.
- Project based Supplementary Examination of classes IX & XI may be conducted as per instructions circulated vide KVS (HQ) letter dated 03.07.2020, after 20th April, 2022 (minimum three weeks after declaration of results).
- These modalities are to be implemented for Session Ending Examination, 2021-22 only as a onetime measure due to prevalent situation of COVID-19 pandemic
- Kindly follow Central/State/District/Local Authorities SOP's Guidelines for conduct of Session Ending Examination, 2021-2022.
- The Deputy Commissioner of the concerned region may modify the mode of examination in administrative exigencies within given framework, if any due to COVID-19.
- The New Academic Session, 2022-23 will begin from 01.04.2022.
